Samokhin A.V. Additional protocol to the agreement on Port-Arthur and Far of the Soviet-Chinese treaty in 1950. Military-and-political aspects

Basing on the analyzed documents, the author comes to the conclusion that the additional agreements on the Soviet-Chinese treaty of 1950 actually were independent documents in which their military-political orientation was most shown in detail. On the one hand they gave confidence to the Chinese government in supporting of the new ally. On the other hand they allowed the USSR to separate from Chinese People's Republic in case of its war with the USA.
