Rozhkovsky V.B. Correlation of the God kenosis idea and “derogation of a man” in Orthodox Russian idea (basic approaches)

Formed in orthodox Russian thought to the understanding of the correlation of ideas of kenosis of God and «belittling of a person» at the end of XIX-th till the first half of XX-th century moral-psychological (metropolitanate Antoniy (Hrapovitsky), M.M.Tareev, A.Chekanovsky, etc.) and ontologic (archiprb.S.Bulgakov, V.N.Lossky, etc.) approaches are reconstructed and analyzed. It is noticed that the ontologic approach more fully and adequately interprets a being of the orthodox thought having sources in patristics, about "prolongation" of kenosis of God (Christ) in "belittling" of a person. Thanks to the ontologic approach it is possible (more fully, than at moral-psychological) to bring a philosophical attention to the question on "presence" of the Christ in the history, culture, about dynamics and prospects of the spiritual experience of a person.
