Pavlov P.V. Phenomenological comprehension of truth

The article is devoted to the problem of truth in the phenomenological conception of E. Husserl. The question of correlation of truth, being and consciousness is considered. The author has proved that phenomenological methodology is elaborate ontological understanding of truth as true being. Theoretical problems of phenomenological conception of truth are analyzed. The author has shown impossibility of reduction of true being to phenomena of «pure» consciousness. The difference between phenomenology of Husserl as non-classical methodology and classical philosophical tradition is marked. Special attention is paid to the importance differences of approaches to understanding of correlation of truth, consciousness and being in the Husserl's phenomenology and Hegel's phenomenology of mind.
