## Vasilenko D.A. Theoretical and methodological basis of hypnotic theories

The problem of personality's psychological health in terms of modern stressing social situation by means of a hypnotic trance providing is considered in the article. The necessity of unified conceptual construct definition and the problem of the hypnotic procedure structural components unity are discussed.
