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Lepin A.P., Filonenko V.I. Family and school – topical problems of interaction in the process of students' socialization

The article presents the results of a comparative analysis of sociological researches of students at high schools in Rostov region, conducted in 2006 and 2011, which revealed a unique place in the secondary education in the process of primary socialization of students. The authors note that the most acute problem for Russian society is the problem of access to quality secondary education. In consequence, the school system in Russia is gradually divided into two, mainly for townspeople and separately for rural residents (for villagers).
