Chourkin M.K. Migration to Siberia: traditions and conditions of new approaches formation

It is considered the problem of the formation of domestic historiography approaches to the assessment of the logic, content and specifics of the resettlement movement in the post-reform Russia. The aim of the article is the identification of a range of issues of the researchers, as well as the discovery of factors that influenced the formulation of the main approaches to the examination of the theme. Accumulating and analyzing long-term historiographic experience of studying the problem, the author came to the conclusion, according to which the attitude of the scientific community to the stated problem has undergone significant evolution. Abandoning the positivist methods of solution of scientific problems of modern historians revealed a number of gaps in the study of the resettlement movement, actively filled in the works of the turn of XX-XXI centuries. However, the author acknowledges the undoubted merits of the researchers of the resettlement issues in earlier times, due to which there has been a significant increase of the source base, prepared methodological ground for the attraction of new methodological approaches to the comprehension of the questions, connected with various aspects of peasant migration in the chronological parameters.
