The article discusses the features of modern terrorism, which are caused by the use of new network technologies, allowing terrorists to use various forms and methods of the negative impact on information-psychological situation in the world in order to create social and psychological shock from the masses of people. In such circumstances, combating terrorism is a complex task, requiring development of clear and effective information policy to combat terrorism, which depends on the interaction between the government and the media.
