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Shapoval G.N., Kamalova O.N. Optimization of foreign students education of medical universities in terms of cultural adaptation within FSES of the third generation

The main purpose of the system of medical education in the light of the introduction of the federal state educational standards of the third generation, focused on rapid adaptation to professional practice is the formation of a specialist who is ready for an independent medical practice in today's level of material and technical equipment of health care. It is revealed the dynamics of motivation in teaching foreign students in medical school, the barriers that arise from them, and negatively affect the motivation of learning, and productivity of the process of the training session. It is shown that the optimization of international students is based on the most important psychological factors and is impossible without taking into account the flow characteristics of adaptive processes. The reasons that determine the level of adaptation of foreign students, the difficulty of their adaptation in comparison with Russian students are underlined. Also it is stressed the importance in the processes of socialization and adaptation of foreign students in the medical school as a media professional values and a representative of culture, including language.
