Noospheric man (homo sapiens noospherus) in the context of anthropological catastrophe

The article considers the problem of a new man formation — homo sapiens noospherus — in the context of the «anthropological catastrophe» and reanthropological processes. Different attributes of the anthropological catastrophe are analyzed in the context of the modern Russian philosophy of man. Comparativistic analyses of the basic terms, used in the anthroposophical interdisciplinary discourse of the XX-th and the beginning of the XXI-th century is conducted through the prism of the system approach. Author comes to the conclusion, that noospheric man is historically determined representation of perfect man idea in post-non-classical society, and proposes an original definition of a «noospheric man» category, based on the terminological analyses of the attributes, uncover ontological and gnoseological nature of the phenomena.
