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The place of the six-member paradigm of the sentences with emotive predicates in the syntactic field of Zolotova G.A. and the paradigm system of Vsevolodova M.V.

A summary of the concept of syntactic field by G.A. Zolotova, as well as a look at the concept of syntactic paradigm, or syntactic field by M.V. Vsevolodova is presented. These views are based on a functional approach to the system of language, given by communicative and constructive aspect of language. The author examines the place of the six-membered paradigm that offers emotional content (ESod) in the syntactic field. This communicative interpretive paradigm is on the periphery of the grammatical and semantic structural modifications, i.e. inner model transformations, one sentence and is monopredicative synonymous variations with components, i.e. intermodel transformations. This is the point of intersection of synonymous sentences constructed by different structural patterns, but united by the same denotation. Each of these six proposals has its own grammar, semantics, expressive and communicative modification.
