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Pedagogical axiology of national science in the problem of self-organization of general cultural competence

The subject of the article is the value foundations of modern pedagogical approaches and technologies projected to a competence paradigm. The formation of common cultural and professional competences is a strategic task of modern educational systems. Its solution requires appropriate methods, approaches and technologies. The theoretical and methodological rationale of their design, in the conditions of crisis of values, is a logical indicator of the transition period experienced by the society.
