Relevant problems of lawyers' speech culture improvement (on the example of the Crimean region)

It has been considered the problems of speech culture in professional language of Crimean lawyers, aspects related to the influence of dialects, sociolects and regiolects on oral and written language of legal professionals. Each professional community has its own specific speech characteristics. For members of such communities, one of the most urgent topics is the level of their common speech culture. The low level of philological competence of lawyers adversely affects the entire system of law enforcement bodies in general, regardless of their specific profile. The discussion about the need to increase the speech culture in this industry is ongoing. That is why higher schools of a legal orientation are obliged to formulate and present certain basic requirements to the philological culture of their pupils. Speech culture of Crimean lawyers is a complex system. It is influenced by a number of factors that cause violations of linguistic norms. The national scientific school is distinguished by the complex nature of the examination of the scientific field of philology of this orientation.
