The political philosophy of N.F. Fedorov as an example of an ideocratic ideology

Scientific discussion of the domestic conservative tradition is especially relevant in the situation of an active search for new ways of social development of modern Russia. Philosophical doctrine of the outstanding thinker of the second half of the XIX century N.F. Fedorov is a pillar of Russian intellectual culture and socio-political «projectivism». The author of this article is committed to the hermeneutic reconstruction of Fedorov's teaching. To accomplish this task, firstly, the concept of ideocratic ideology as an "idealistic" conceptual structure is introduced. Secondly, the ideocratic essence of the philosophy of the "General Cause" is grounded.
