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Formation of the student personality at schools of the Chechen Republic through mobilization of ethnocultural values

The need for comprehensive consideration of the problems of the all-round development of the child's personality prompts to focus on the study of schools in the Chechen Republic, where it is possible to implement the educational process through the use of ethno-cultural characteristics and spiritual values of the people.
