Personal pronoun as an expressive means of creating the reflecting character's inner monologue subjective space

It is considered the personal pronoun as a means of creating individual space of a reflecting character. Speech behavior of a pronoun as an inner monologue connecting element is under research. Pronoun 'one' is proposed as the object of the research as a means of creating subjectivity. It is proved that personal pronouns serve as a structural-semantic linking element in the inner monologue. Having analyzed various contexts, we can conclude that the pronoun 'one' intensifies the reflecting character inner monologue subjective component, muting the narrator's voice and shaping the character's flow of conscience from the perspective of the character's subjective outlook.
