Ecolinguistic concepts «БЕЛОЕ БЕЗМОЛВИЕ» / «WHITE SILENCE» and their lexicographic representation

It is considered the features of the ecolinguistic concepts БЕЛОЕ БЕЗМОЛВИЕ and WHITE SILENCE. The interdisciplinarity of ecolinguistic concepts determines the relevance and the need for further research. The structure of the concept БЕЛОЕ БЕЗМОЛВИЕ in Russian, and the concept of WHITE SILENCE in English based on lexicographic sources are characterized. Considering the "natural" two-part concepts, the author takes into account the fact that the "environmental" component of the studied concepts is expanded and supplemented when studying them in the idiostyle of Russian and American authors. The integration of basic concepts of ecology and linguistics helps to reveal the national-mental features of the semantics of the analyzed language units. In this regard, the author attempted to analyze the lexical design of the concepts БЕЛОЕ БЕЗМОЛВИЕ / WHITE SILENCE in Russian and English culture. In the study, the author relies on authoritative dictionaries of Russian and English languages.
