Evolution of the Korean language in the context of the Korean literature of New time

It is considered the evolution of the Korean language in the context of the literature of the new time. Korean literature absorbs the meaning of certain events: the Japanese occupation, the Korean War, the globalization of the English language. The main paradigm of Korean fiction was set in the first half of the XX century. In connection with subsequent events (liberation from Japanese oppression, civil war and division of the country into 2 parts) proletarian writers settled in the north of the country, where they wrote about the successes in creation the communist system, and continued to delve into the western literary tradition. Despite all the upheavals, Korean writers remain faithful to the traditions of their original literature, as can be seen, for example, in modern novels, giving greater importance to the meanings rather than form.
