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Pandemic Covid-2019 as a destabilization factor and the transformation of the spiritual and moral life of the modern person: existential-value aspect

The article justifies the relevance of the philosophical approach to understanding the problem of the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on the spiritual and moral life of modern society. In the aspect of the existential and value foundations of the existence of a modern personality, emphasis is placed on the need to rethink the transformation of modern realities in a Covid-2019 pandemic. In this regard, the key concept of this article is the phenomenon of "alienation", which is considered as a certain result of opposites and contradictions in reality, as a certain process of overcoming the contradictions that arise in the individual's thinking. These contradictions are aggravated in understanding the essence of good and evil, the manifestation of spirituality, «conciliarity», mutual assistance, collectivism, which are so necessary in situations of unstable development of society. It is concluded that in the context of the unstable development of society, one should learn to build one's own concept of transhumanism, that is, to carry out a «value revolution» in one's mind.
