Features of the use of non-deterministic thematically motivated vocabulary

The purpose of the study is to identify the communicative preference for the use of appropriate categories of non-deterministic thematically motivated vocabulary by certain communicative groups of authors. The scientific novelty lies in the analysis of structural varieties of non-deterministic vocabulary as an integral part of thematically motivated figure skating vocabulary. For the first time, the special vocabulary of this sport (professionalism, jargon), newspaper vocabulary used in the relevant materials are described and analyzed linguistically. The results showed that the ratio of categories of thematically motivated figure skating vocabulary is disproportionate. Professionalisms, jargonisms of this sport are not widely used in the oral speech of its representatives, are rarely used in the media. It follows from the conducted research: thematically motivated vocabulary and communicative groups of authors are interrelated linguistic realities. The use of certain layers of vocabulary motivated by the theme of the text depends on the author's knowledge of the specifics, depth of the subject, possession of newspaper and journalistic style.
