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### **Growth and activation of interfix models in modern Russian**

Changes in the morphological structure of a derived word are one of the slowest processes in a language. The “undermining” of existing morphological norms occurs gradually, imperceptibly, because they are protected both by unconscious habits of speaking and by a conscious struggle for the stability of the literary language. Morphological changes are most noticeable in words derived from stems of a special kind, these are: derivatives of borrowings that have stems with an outcome in vowels; derivatives of abbreviations of various types, derivatives of toponyms; derivatives of names (including several words) of all kinds - institutions, societies, mechanisms, publications, etc.
