### **Analysis of the features of unstressed vocalism of some dialects south of Voronezh**

It is considered the dialects of the southern districts of the Voronezh region from the point of view of unstressed vocalism. The study of these dialects is of scientific interest, since they reflect the history of the Voronezh Region, which was populated unevenly by immigrants from different regions of the country. There are differences in the system of pre-stressed vocalism after soft consonants: in the studied dialects south of Voronezh, there are different types of ya-sound (strong, moderate, dissimilative, moderate-dissimilative, assimilative-dissimilative), implemented in part of dialects with various phonetic or morphological limitations. A characteristic feature of the development of Voronezh dialects is noted – none of the models of pre-stressed vocalism after soft consonants is presented without deviations. In the system of unstressed vocalism, after hard consonants, non-assimilative ay-sound prevails, as in a literary language.
