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Complex sentences in the Chechen language

An attempt is made to express a certain point of view on the problem of hypotaxis in the Caucasian and, in particular, in the Chechen language. The methods correspond to the direction of comparative historical linguistics, i.e. as the main method, a comparative-historical method is used, aimed at identifying both similar and different structural features in the compared languages. Thus, the subordinate clause is expressed using syntactic and morphological means: a subordinate affix attached to the form of the verb-predicate, various semi-predicative phrases.
