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Phraseologism as a language unit

Phraseological units are studied from the point of view of the presence or absence of certain characteristics in the light of ongoing discussions about which units can be included in the field of phraseology and which ones cannot, what characteristics a phraseological unit should have in order to be called such, what is the component composition of a phrase that can be attributed to phraseology. The characteristics that are traditionally given to phraseological units are analyzed: reproducibility, indivisibility, imagery, connotativity, stylistic coloring. The components by which phraseological units are differentiated are studied, their features are analyzed, conclusions are drawn regarding the validity of a particular interpretation. Phraseology is considered as a complexly structured, diverse, multidimensional linguistic unit.
