The globalizing world in the work of A.S. Panarin "The Temptation of Globalism"

The article is devoted to A.S. Panarin's understanding of the problems of the structurogenesis of the global world. Alexander Panarin is sometimes, and not without reason, called a brilliant forecaster, and sometimes even a prophet. It is noted that A.S. Panarin interpreted globalization as a deconstruction of sovereign national states and national communities, opening up the possibility of elites leaving the system of national control. It is shown that with the change in the global political climate in recent years, the views of this outstanding scientist on globalization and countering it have become even more relevant than a quarter of a century ago, when he wrote the book "The Temptation of Globalism". Attention is focused on the problem of the relationship between globalization and postmodernity. The conclusion is made about the importance and necessity of using Pan-Tatar theses in discussions about the ways of social progress in the modern world.
