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Linguistic peculiarities of the latest neologisms of the English language: lexico-semantic aspect

The article examines the lexico-semantic features of the latest neologisms in the English language. Both strong and weak linguistic, lexical and semantic neologisms are considered. The systematization of new words in the English language in terms of their semantics is carried out. It has been established that the lexico-semantic peculiarities of new words are also manifested in their ability to expand the denotative meanings of existing words and phrases and closely related phenomena of polysemy and homonymy, as well as in the development of synonymic connections within thematic groups or antonymic connections to denote opposite phenomena.
