The interpersonal relationships and the problem of their classification

This article is devoted to the study and analysis of the notions in the sphere of research of relationships, interpersonal relationships as a special type of relations and some peculiarities of their linguistic representation in the British musical discourse. The main factors of their categorization are social needs, personal values, the level of development, but the basic factor is emotions due to their universal and unique status fs regulating process in this sphere. We define five categories: the category “I” characterizing the person’s attitude to himself as a personality; the category “Family”; the category “Friends” that is the reflection of the person’s need: the category “Love interest” characterizing a person as a potential partner; the category “Strangers” – people helping a person express relationships between him and people surrounding him.
