On the issue of pedagogical conditions for the formation of students' educational culture in the process of mastering a foreign language in a non-linguistic university

The works of domestic and foreign authors reflecting modern concepts related to the organization of educational activities have been analyzed. It is emphasized that both Russian and foreign education systems are characterized by an appeal to a competence-based approach at all educational levels. It is shown that an attempt has been made in the educational space of Germany to solve the problem of improving the quality of education by integrating a competence-based and cultural approach. The article presents the experience of forming the educational culture of students on the basis of a competence approach in the process of studying the subject "Foreign language (second, introductory course)".
