## Development of soft skills or how higher education institutions form qualified specialists

The article examines the importance of soft skills such as communication, critical thinking, teamwork and creativity in the context of training qualified personnel for a rapidly changing labor market. It is shown that the integration of these skills into educational programs becomes the pinnacle of the educational process, which allows graduates to successfully adapt to a professional environment. The existing approaches to learning are analyzed, the need for specialized courses and the introduction of practical teaching methods, such as role-playing games and group projects, is emphasized.
