Family values in Russian philosophy: a historical review on the example of the views of S.L. Frank and I.A. Ilyin

An in-depth historical and philosophical analysis of family values in the Russian philosophical tradition is conducted with an emphasis on the ideas of S.L. Frank and I.A. Ilyin. The author examines the philosophical understanding of family and marriage not only as social institutions, but also as spiritual phenomena that play a key role in the formation of the individual and society. Special attention is paid to the concept of catholicity in Frank's interpretation, which reveals the family as an organic unity based on the inner spiritual bond of the spouses. Ilyin's views on marriage emphasize its ethical and spiritual purpose, where the union of spouses is seen as a path to their personal and moral improvement.
