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Classification of stylistic means as a reflection of the features of artistic style

The structure of a literary text is multidimensional and ambiguous for perception. The analysis of a literary text reveals not only its semantics, grammatical and compositional structure, but also its stylistic features. The linguistic stylistics of a literary text occupies a special place in linguistics and is aimed at identifying and analyzing linguistic means. As a rule, stylistic means are divided into pictorial and expressive. Expressive means, or figures of speech, increase the expressiveness and emotionality of speech, but are not aimed at forming images. The main approaches to classifying stylistic means as the most relevant form of expression in a literary text are considered.
