## New forms of human existence in a technocratic future

Philosophical and analytical modeling of the technocratic future scenario is presented, in which algorithms, artificial intelligence, biotechnologies and digital infrastructure rebuild the social fabric of society and radically transform human existence and traditional institutions. The key consequences identified in the course of the study concerning the ontological status of a person are revealed: personal autonomy and spontaneity of behavior can be devalued under the influence of external performance metrics, and technological comfort creates the danger of loss of self-reflection and free will. It is shown that the focus on the "external management" of the subject and the marginal rationality of risk is fraught with depersonalization and the potential replacement of basic political and ethical institutions with algorithmic modules. The processes of "automation" of identity are considered in detail: the transfer of consciousness, the formation of collective superconsciousness and the emergence of a "functional unconscious" (regulated from the outside).
