Psychoanalytic identity in the era of digitalization: features of training psychoanalytically oriented specialists

The article presents the influence of digital culture on the formation of the subject from the standpoint of psychoanalysis, identifies the features of intersubjective interaction in virtual space, and describes the key aspects of the influence of virtual space on the psychic functioning of the subject. The problem of adapting psychoanalysis to changes caused by digital culture is posed. The psychic, clinical and technical features of remote psychoanalytic practice are considered. The main stages and tasks of training psychoanalytically oriented specialists capable of working with specific aspects of psychoanalytic practice in virtual space and the digital environment are formulated. Particular emphasis is placed on the primary importance of the internal setting of a psychoanalytically oriented specialist. The importance of psychoanalytic ethics in the training of psychoanalytically oriented specialists is emphasized.
