Socio-philosophical analysis of social reality

A socio-philosophical understanding of social reality and its ontological status is carried out through the prism of the genesis of ideas about this phenomenon. The process of forming ideas about social reality is investigated and epistemological shifts in the temporal explication of this phenomenon, caused by dominant ideological concepts, are revealed. The research focuses on the key stages of the transformation of understanding social reality: from the immanent cosmological discourse of anarchy through the transcendent-oriented paradigm of theocentrism that prevailed during the Middle Ages, to the anthropocentric shift of the Renaissance and further to the rational approach in Modern times and its reinterpretation in modern times.
