The anti-humanistic orientation of future strategies in transhumanism

The strategies of the future of man in transhumanism are analyzed. It is emphasized that in modern society, humanism is being replaced by transhumanism, which, although it appears to be its final stage, is actually based on a fundamentally different attitude: the need and possibility of purposeful change in the human condition itself. The technization of man threatens the very nature of Homo Sapiens, as it aims to overcome human nature itself - imperfect flesh and weak consciousness. One of the goals and most important characteristics of transhumanism is fundamental immortalism. It is shown that the full potential of transhumanism is focused on rejecting, separating (eliminating) human consciousness and further moving on to deep manipulations with it. The anti-humanistic essence of transhumanism consists in the interiorization of the values of eternal life. This means the self-destruction of humanism, since human rights are declared to be its modification to such an extent that the essence of humanity disappears altogether.
