Pragmalinguistic features of Internet users' comments on political articles about international conflicts (based on comments on news articles about the US and Israel's attack on Iran)

An extended pragmalinguistic analysis of comments on news political articles about international conflicts that provoke a strong reaction from Russian-speaking Internet users is presented. A classification of strategies and tactics typical for the situation of commenting on a news political article is carried out. It is established that the comments under consideration are dominated by a textocentric strategy of negative response, using which commentators show verbal aggression towards one of the parties to the conflict. The presence in the comments under consideration of a positive response strategy aimed at supporting one of the parties to the conflict and implemented through tactics of approval, empathy and wishes is noted. These strategies correspond to various linguistic means, including phraseologized statements and phraseological units, allusions, antonyms, neologisms, invectives, colloquialisms, metaphors, antonomasia, oxymorons, contrast and rhetorical questions.
